Although scar tissue is dense, it responds best to light touch. This method results in lasting functional changes as well as cosmetic and tactile improvement. Most natural and surgical scars of any age respond well.

Attendees will learn a variety of techniques through demonstration and practical experience working on 'models'/volunteers during three supervised clinics. The techniques use light touch, are simple to learn, easy to perform, and can be incorporated into your practice immediately to benefit clients with various scars including mastectomy, hip/knee replacement, C-section, hysterectomy, etc.
